When I was in high school, there was a girl in our class who was incredibly smart and cared so much about doing well in school that it was rumored she buckled her backpack into her passenger seat both to and from school. Whether it's true or not, I'll never know for sure. Either way, her utter devotion to her studies was demonstrated in the ways she spent her time and energy. When there was reading to be done, she read every word—and made notes! When there was a test, she was always well-prepared, because she didn't even understand the meaning of cramming.

LEVELS OF BIBLICAL LEARNING // GOD

Day One **COLOSSIANS 1:15**

Many people refuse to follow Christ because they deny that He is God. It's definitely a concept that's difficult to grasp—that there is one God, and Jesus, the Son of God, is Himself God. Yet this is absolutely true! In fact, that Jesus is God and, at the same time, man is one of the most important truths of our faith. In the Old Testament, God revealed Himself to His people, but they didn't see Him as clearly as we do today. In Hebrews 1, we learn that Jesus is better than the law, better than the prophets, and better than the angels because, in Him, we have the perfect picture of the character and person of God. Further. He is the "firstborn" who is over all creation. This doesn't mean He was born first in the sense of time. Instead, it means that He is first-place—highest in rank—and the one with the right to inherit all creation. Following Christ requires that we acknowledge Him as God and place Him first in our lives.

Day Two

COLOSSIANS 1:16



In Genesis 1, we read that God created all that exists in six days. Because Jesus is God, He was involved in this. Here, we read that everything was created not only by Jesus, but also through Him and even for Him. Jesus' involvement in creation reveals to us that He is powerful in ways that we could never truly grasp. That He walked on water is absolutely incredible. That He raised the dead is even harder to imagine. But His creating the universe out of nothing—that's simply outside our capacity to comprehend. And don't miss this. It was all created for Him, so we would understand His power and greatness.

Day Three **COLOSSIANS 1:17**

In verse 15, we read that Jesus is the firstborn over all creation. Here, Paul wrote to the Colossian church that Jesus is before all things. Whereas Christ's being firstborn speaks to His right to inherit, before speaks to Jesus' existing before all the universe came to be. Just as God revealed Himself to Moses as I Am, He is refers emphatically to Jesus' eternally existing as God. And with the same power He used in establishing the heavens and earth. He continues to hold the world together. It is Christ who sustains us, not only in our faith as we walk in the ways God has called us, but literally and physically as well. Without Jesus' sustaining power, all that is would simply cease to be. But because of the power of Jesus, space and time continue on, and all for the glory of God.

Day Four COLOSSIANS 1:18

Jesus is the beginning, not just in terms of the physical universe, but in the spiritual realm as well. Because of sin, all people must die. The price for sin is death, and because God is just, He couldn't simply ignore our rebellion against Him. However, all along God had a plan to deal with our sin. He sent Jesus to live the perfect life that we never could and to die as the payment for our sins. Still, these things weren't enough to deal with our sins. Thankfully, death was not strong enough to hold Jesus, and He was walked out of the tomb on the third day. He is, by virtue of His resurrection. the firstborn from the dead. He is first place in everything, and because of His resurrection, we are raised with Him to eternal life

Day Five

COLOSSIANS 1:19-20



"For God was pleased"—it's not difficult to grasp that God was pleased to have His full character dwell in Jesus, so people could clearly see God. It also makes sense that God was pleased to, through Christ, reconcile lost people to Himself. However, it's not easy at all to grasp that God was pleased that these involved Jesus' blood being shed on the cross. The truth is that God's character was most clearly displayed in the sacrifice of Jesus, and this was the only way to redeem sinful people from sin. Even Jesus' sacrifice pleased God because, without this happening, we could never know Him.
